Parents Suzanne and Chris Shoemaker have volunteered their services as Santa and Mrs. Claus in order to help raise funds to support the swim team's trips to the outer islands and the mainland for State and regional meets during 1989.

Any time during December up until 5 p.m. on Christmas Eve, Santa and Mrs. Claus can be "rented" to surprise the children (or your friends and co-workers), deliver presents, and listen to last-minute Christmas wishes from the little ones. Special arrangements can also be made for elves and carolers to accompany Santa. Just call the Shoemakers to make your party arrangements at 395-5915. If they're not home, be sure to leave a message on the recorder and they will get right back to you.

Rates for visits by Santa are \$35 for a half hour visit and \$50 for an hour visit, with complimentary carolers included, depending upon time and availability. Or rent Santa and Mrs. Claus for an entire family or office party for only \$100, and know that your money will be going to the fine cause of supporting our local Hawaii Kai swimmers.

The Shoemakers, parents of Justin, 9, and Jared, 14, are no novices to acting out the Santa Claus role or other roles. Although new to Hawaii, they are professional actors and directors who moved here from China where they had been performing most recently. Prior to that, they lived in Paris where they performed in "Comedie Francais" and the National Circus of Paris. They have also worked in the International Festival in Edinburgh, Scotland, the largest theater festival in the world; and performed Shakespeare in England and Canada.

The Hawaii Kai Swim Team, which includes 67 local swimmers, will also be sponsoring another Christmas service to East Honolulu residents in order to earn money for their travels. Senior team members and their parents have volunteered to wrap Christmas packages at Koko Marina throughout the busy holiday shopping season. They will be available to all of you busy shoppers every weekend throughout December, and selected weeknights as the Big Day draws nearer.

The team hopes to raise a total of \$9,000 through these and other fundraising events in order to support trips by swimmers and coaches to meets in Hilo and Maui in the spring; to national competition in Phoenix, Arizona next August; and possibly to the Junior National Championships for the very top swimmers.

Last year, the team was successful in raising \$4,000 through events such as car-



washes and through the generous financial support of several corporate sponsors, including Kaiser Development Corporation, Moore Business Forms, Hawaii Kai Golf Course, Manichi Sports, the Oahu Club, and Theo H.
